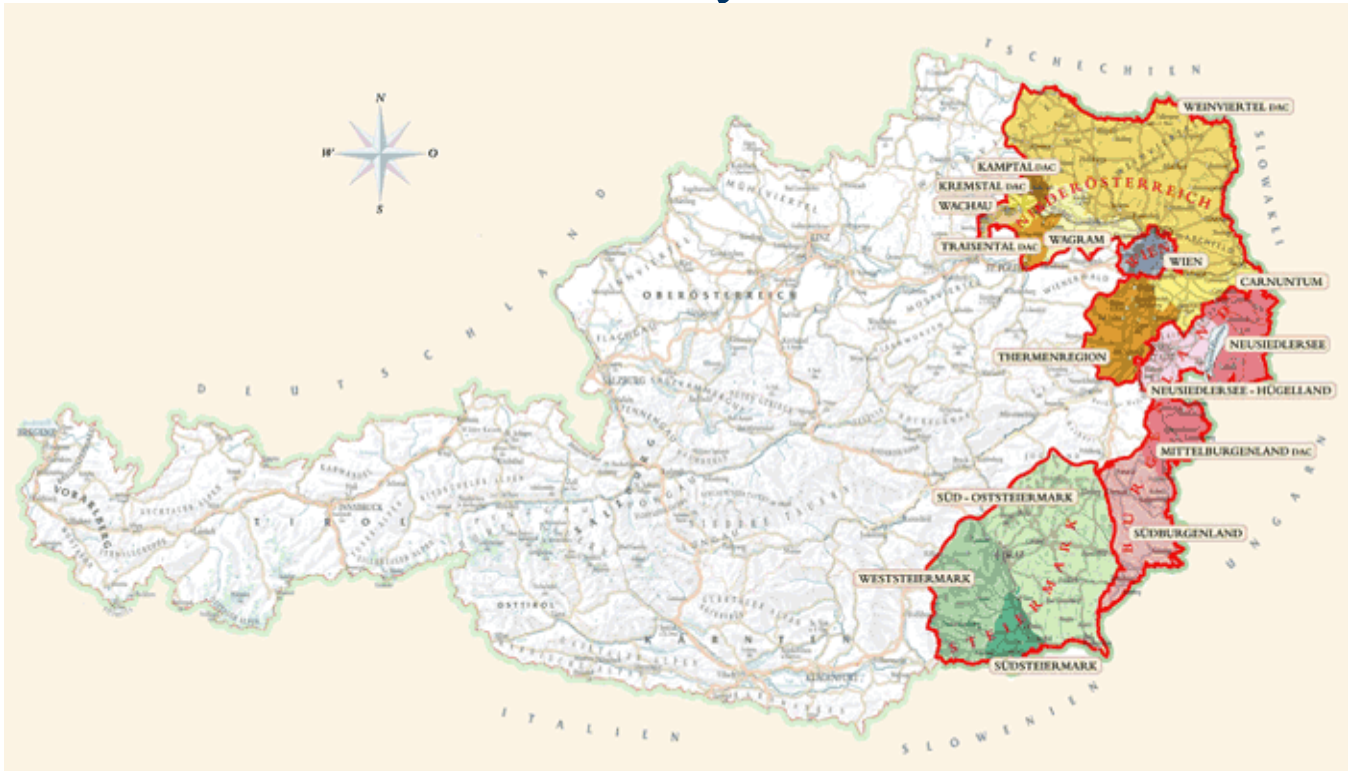

is a traditional grape which is mainly grown in Styria. It captivates with its typically fruity tone with fragrances of elderberry and green apple. The Muscatel is a somewhat light white wine, but one which is multi-layered and harmonious in flavour.

is distinguished by its freshness, somewhat zesty fruitiness and a pleasant, finely aromatic and somewhat acidic flavour. Because of its especially fruity character, a good Welschriesling is reminiscent in flavour of a juicy apple.

also known as Muskat Sylvaner, is distinguished by a boldness marked by juicy acidity, a wealth of extracts and alcohol, and by its generally grassy aroma. It is mostly grown in Styria.

➤ Weißburgunder

also known as Pinot blanc or Klevner. Production restrictions at wineries and a corresponding maturity of the grape at harvest time are very important for this wine. The Weißburgunder is elegant, harmonious, full-flavoured and extract-rich, with intermediate alcohol content, somewhat neutral and unobtrusive to the palate.

➤ Grüner Veltliner

is cultivated on some 36% of Austria's wine-growing land. Its bouquet is generally notably fruity. A high-quality Veltliner is distinguished by its freshness, zestiness, a good acidic background and a finely aromatic, slightly peppery aftertaste. This wine is grown primarily in Vienna and Lower Austria.

➤ Riesling

For good Riesling quality, full maturity of the berries is an absolute requirement in order to attain the necessary sugar content. In combination with the characteristic acidity, this causes the wonderful harmony we find in Riesling wines. A good Riesling is always pleasantly surprising with its incomparable interplay of fragrances and a virtually perfect balance of acidity, sweetness, body and elegance.

➤ Chardonnay

also called Morillon in Styria, requires a certain maturing in the vat and bottles in order to develop its full flavour, thus often being stored in Barrique barrels. Always typical is the exceptional fruitiness of fragrance and aroma, frequently compared with ripe grapes or apples. Chardonnay is generally a rich, full-bodied wine.

is also known by the name *Pinot gris* or *Ruländer*. A voluminous wine, dense and robust with deep fruity components. This wine is distinguished by its exceptional and intense nose of caramel and apricots, and by the creamily soft, sustained aftertaste. An excellent companion to dark meats.

It possesses a fruity and very fragrant aroma, with the wine's fragrance also reminiscent of roses. This wine is exceptionally full-bodied, very rich in extracts, dense with relatively low acidity, yet with a fruity character.

<u>Spätlese:</u>	min. 19 degrees KMW	fully matured grapes
<u>Auslese:</u>	21 degrees KMW	from select grapes
<u>Beerenauslese:</u>	25 degrees KMW	over-ripe and affected by noble rot
<u>Ausbruch:</u>	27 degrees KMW	over-ripe berries affected by noble rot, allowed to dry out
<u>Trockenbeerenauslese:</u>	30 degrees KMW	berries allowed to attain noble rot, generally shrivelled
<u>Eiswein:</u>	25 degrees KMW	berries are frozen at harvest and during processing
<u>Strohwein:</u>	25 degrees KMW	fully mature, high-sugar berries, laid out for min. 3 months on straw or reeds

KMW = Klosterneuburger Mostwaage
25 ° KMW means – the grape must has 25% sugar content
or 250 g sugar in 1 l of must

➤ Blaufränkisch

is generally regarded as one of the best and most expressive red wines in Austria. It has a refined fruity bouquet and is fresh, racy and possesses fine acidity. It is robust with a subtle tannin content. Especially notable is its enormous fruitiness and its stabile acidic content.

➤ Zweigelt

is a cross between the St. Laurent and Blaufränkisch grape, named after its creator. The Zweigelt is a red wine, whose quality is guaranteed by production limits imposed on vineyards. Its bouquet is fruity and aromatic and it is distinguished by a full-bodied, slightly fruity flavour, rich in extract and with an appropriate tannin content.

➤ Merlot

originally comes from France and is now commonly grown in Austria. It is distinguished by its smooth character. This wine has a mild acidity and no hard tannins, making it pleasant and accessible.

➤ St. Laurent

owes its name to Saint Lawrence, on whose name day (August 10) the grape generally begins to mature. The St. Laurent possesses a strong, dark-red colour, while its fine, fruity bouquet is reminiscent of sour cherries. With a degree of maturity, the wine tastes velvety and full-flavoured, while having a pleasant tannin content.

is a very high-quality red wine, one of Austria's top products in the red-wine sector. It possesses a radiant ruby-red colour with violet nuances and a fine, fruity bouquet of bitter almonds. The wine tastes velvety, round, is expressive, relatively high in extract content and has a subtle tannin content.

➤ Top Red-Wine Cuvées

The term Cuvée refers to a wine created from different grape varieties, blended together in specific proportions to achieve a unique flavour. This form of wine-making has been practiced in France since time immemorial, especially in Bordeaux. In Austria, too, very interesting wines have resulted from this same technique in recent years.
